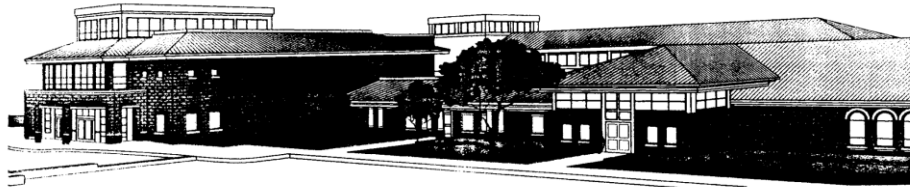

A Tribute to the Female Vocalists of the '40s and '50s



Red Light Roxy is a professional band from Cleveland, Ohio that plays an upbeat mix of jazz standards, jump blues, swing, boogie-woogie and a dash of old-school R&B. Its repertoire comes from the Great American Songbook and includes familiar songs made famous by such legendary performers as Ella Fitzgerald, Ruth Brown, Frank Sinatra, Peggy Lee, Nat King Cole, Ray Charles and Louis Armstrong.

Girl Singers pays tribute to the classic female vocalists of the 40s and 50s. Take a trip down memory lane with the songs and stories of ladies like Doris Day, Rosemary Clooney, Billie Holiday, Peggy Lee and more. Makes for a perfect afternoon program for libraries, senior groups or anyone who loves the Great American Songbook and the women who immortalized the songs.

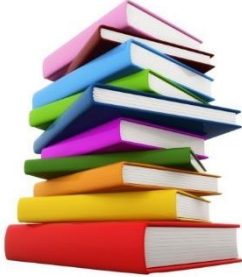

The BOOK NOOK will be **closing after January 22, 2020** to get ready for our February book sale. We will reopen mid-February once we have cleaned the room and started re-stocking the shelves. Reopening information will be on the Friends' website.



DONATIONS to the BOOK NOOK:

We appreciate those of you who have generously donated quality books to the Book Nook. Donated books and other items play an important role in the success of the Book Nook and our annual big book sale.

We will ACCEPT: 1. Gently used fiction and non-fiction, both hardcover and paperback, in good condition, including children's and young adult books. 2. Commercially produced media i.e. DVD's, CD's (audiobooks and music) 3. Gently used puzzles and games with all pieces intact.

We will ACCEPT these materials if they are less than 3 years old: 1. Computer books. 2. Test prep books. 3. Health or medical books. 4. Travel guides.

We will NOT ACCEPT: Damaged books with broken bindings, missing pages or covers, soiled, musty, moldy, covered in cobwebs and bugs, or with smoke or water damage. There can be health hazards for the volunteers sorting through books that have been stored in boxes or bags in a garage, attic or basement; they may be affected by mold, dirt, insects or animal residue. These types of items are not fun to sort through and are often taken directly to trash.

We do NOT ACCEPT encyclopedias, cassette and VHS tapes, or homemade copies of movies, music and software.

Neither library staff or Friends' volunteers can assist you in transporting donations from your vehicle. Carts are available – ask at the Reception Desk.

The reason we need to have limits as to what we can accept is because all donated materials require volunteer time to sort, and materials not meeting our criteria must be taken to trash or put on the free cart. Most of our volunteers are at the stage in life where lifting and carting boxes to trash is an effort, and could cause injury. Please help us continue to offer quality books in the Book Nook and at our February sale, and keep our volunteers safe.
